Allergic diseases are common; 20-30% of the population experience some form of allergy, which imposes a physical and economic burden that often compromises productivity and quality of life. The prevalence of allergic diseases in the western world has increased, and so has asthma in children. Scientifically, “allergy” refers to unwanted and overt immunological responses to foreign antigens that may include inhaled, food, contact and sting-mediated exposure to these antigens or allergens. We will discuss 1) how allergy is triggered, 2) detection of allergy, 3) available treatment options for an allergic patient and 4) prevalent local allergens in the Las Vegas valley.
