Dr. Dwayne Smith

Dr. Smith has been at USF since the Fall of 2000 after holding academic appointments at Tulane University and the University of North Carolina – Charlotte. He came to USF as Professor and Chair of the Department of Criminology, and was named Vice Provost in 2005, then Senior Vice Provost in 2008. In 2013, he was also appointed as Dean of the Office of Graduate Studies. In 2022, he stepped down from those administrative positions to return to the Criminology faculty. A USFFCU member since joining USF, Dr. Smith has served as Co-Vice Chair of the Board for the past 6 years. Prior to that, he served as a Board member for 3 years, Associate Board member for 1 year, and a member of the Supervisory Committee for 4 years.
