The Scholarship Committee of the Area Credit Union Outreach Alliance (CACUOA) invites you to apply for a scholarship. There will be at least nine scholarships awarded at \$1,000 each. To qualify, you must be at least a senior in a local high school and plan to enroll in post-high school studies, including vocational, professional and academic studies, which are not limited to colleges and universities. Applicants may also be anyone who is obtaining an Associate or Bachelor Degree. You yourself must be a primary member of an Ohio Credit Union that has branches in one of the Cincinnati area counties to be eligible. (Cincinnati Area Counties are: Hamilton, Butler, Warren, Clermont, Brown, and Adams.)

How has your experience with or knowledge of credit unions shaped your perspective on financial health?
